Marching Band Members,

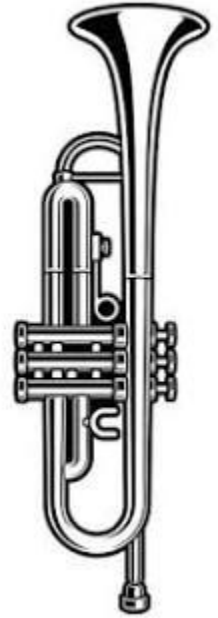
